#### PERSECUTION IS PROMISED

Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have tribulation. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. The one who conquers will not be hurt by the second death. -Rev. 2:10-22

Exile (Revelation 1:9)




## PERSECUTION IS PROMISED

"I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." -John 16:33

**BUT JESUS ALREADY WON**

### EVIL PEOPLE AND IMPOSTERS BRING PERSECUTION

- Target: All who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus (v. 12)
- **Perpetrators:** Evil people--those outside the church who hate Christ, and imposters--those inside the church who hate Christ secretly. (v. 13)
- **Severity:** They go from bad to worse, indicating a steady progression of persecution and deceit (v. 12)
- **Method:** Deceiving and being deceived. Their father is the great deceiver, so their method is deception.

10 You, however, have followed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, 11 my persecutions and sufferings that happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, and at Lystra—which persecutions I endured; yet from them all the Lord rescued me. 12 Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, 13 while evil people and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. 14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it 15 and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. 16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.





## SCRIPTURE HELPS IN PERSECUTION

- **Doctrine:** Hold fast to the faithful doctrine your parents taught you. (v. 14)
- **Scripture:** God's Word is what makes us wise for salvation. (v. 15)
  - **-Scripture is God-breathed:** It is the ultimate authority and without error.
  - -Scripture is Sufficient: It provides everything needed for spiritual maturity.

In persecution, we are to hold fast to faithful doctrine and use Scripture to teach, reproof, correct, and train.

18 "If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you. 19 If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. 20 Remember the word that I said to you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours. 21 But all these things they will do to you on account of my name, because they do not know him who sent me.22 If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have been guilty of sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin. 23 Whoever hates me hates my Father also. 24 If I had not done among them the works that no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin, but now they have seen and hated both me and my Father. 25 But the word that is written in their Law must be fulfilled: 'They hated me without a cause.' 26 "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.27 And you also will bear witness, because you have been with me from the beginning.





**REJOICE**

## HELP IN PERSECUTION HOLY SPIRIT

- **Assistance:** He is called the "Helper"
- Confirmation: He bears witness about Christ.
- **New Testament:** The apostles likewise bore witness in Scripture with His help.

#### PERSECUTED GAIN THE KINGDOM OF GOD

10 "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.11 "Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. 12 Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

#### PERSECUTED GAIN 100 FOLD AND MORE

#### PERSECUTION MAKES US STRONG IN CHRIST

## TO OBEY IS BETTER THAN SACRIFICE (1 SAM. 15:22)


Live a godly life in Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 3:12)

Live peacable in as much as it is up to you (Romans 12:18)


- Be faithful to assemble with the body of Christ. (Hebrews 10:23-25)

Be faithful in the everyday obedience to God's commands. The normal Christian life is how God is most glorified and His Kingdom is built.






